We ask that parents:

- Contact the school directly to speak to their child's Tutor if they have a concern
- Support the school sanctions for misbehaviour
- Attend parents' evenings, annual reviews, Pastoral Support Plan reviews and any other meetings arranged to support learning
- Do not take their child on holiday during term time
- Support their child to complete homework
- Avoid using social media in ways that could damage the school's reputation in the community

- Strive to provide a welcoming and caring environment whereby each member of the school community feels wanted, valued and safe

USE OF ICT FACILITIES

Introduction

The computer system is owned by the school and is made available to students as an enrichment tool to further their education. The school's ICT policy has been drawn up to ensure that students do not endanger themselves or other students, or give themselves or the school a bad reputation.

The school will ensure that there are proper systems in place to support the student's safe use of the internet. If computers in the school are used to harm another person, or an accident happens, it will be dealt with properly by the school. The school reserves the right to examine or delete any files, emails or messages that may be held on its computer system, or monitor any internet sites visited.

The responsibilities of the student are to:

- Access the computer network, email or VLE using their own user name and password. Keep passwords private.
- Never alter the computer or monitor settings, or interfere with computers being used by other students.
- Always follow the teacher's instructions when using the internet.
- Be careful about what is sent electronically. Do not write or send anything that could upset or offend others.
- Keep safe. Do not give out personal information in an e-mail, message or on a website.
- Let a teacher or a member of staff know if anything is received that makes them feel uncomfortable.
- Never bring any programs or copyright material in to the school.
- Understand that The Roundhill Academy operates a print credit system. Students may purchase extra credits for personal printing.
- Not bring the school into disrepute on any social media site.

If you break the rules concerning the use of The Roundhill Academy's ICT facilities, the following could happen:

- You may be banned or have restricted use of e-mail, messaging or internet for a particular period of time.
- Contact may be made with your parents.
- The school may take disciplinary action against you.
- Your actions may be reported to the police or other law enforcement agency if you breach the terms of the policy.
