### **Macbeth - Derby Theatre Trip**

We are offering the opportunity for Year 11 English students to see a production of Macbeth at the Derby Theatre. This is an excellent opportunity to learn outside of the classroom. They will witness first-hand the extraordinary theatre production of a text we will have studied for their English Literature GCSE. Seeing the text performed, as a play is meant to be, will enhance students' understanding of the text and its complex themes and ideas.

The visit will take place on **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020**.

Students will leave school at **12.20pm** and return by approximately **5.00pm** (TBC). Arrangements for students to be picked up by parents/carers must be made if students normally make use of the school bus.

**The total cost of the trip will be £20.00** (see price structure if eligible for free school meals or any other benefits). This is a self-financing trip, which will only go ahead if sufficient contributions are received.

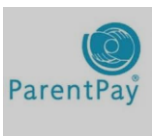
#### **Eligibility for Trips and Visits**

Visits are viewed as rewards. Students are representing the school publicly and so students should only be rewarded with places on visits and trips if they:

- Have good attendance;
- Have good behaviour;
- Put effort into their work;
- Wear correct school uniform.

There are only 94 spaces available on this trip, therefore in the event of oversubscription after the aforementioned conditions have been applied, names will be drawn from a hat.

We would be grateful if you could make payment using ParentPay which is our preferred method of payment.
