Dear Parent/Carer

I am sure you will be aware by now of the lockdown arrangements that have been put into place in Leicester. The Roundhill Academy falls within the lockdown area and therefore will be reducing back down to providing provision only for those young people who are in the care of key workers or are likely to be vulnerable during this period of time.

The timing of the lockdown measures mean that we will not be returning to any increased provision before the summer break. All provision at Roundhill will end for the summer on Friday 10th July. I wanted to let you know at this point of our plans for the return to school in September. Clearly these plans are very much subject to change but we feel they match the stated aim of returning all students to school by September 1st, whilst also allowing us to re-establish some confidence and routines amongst our young people.

In Leicestershire the term starts just prior to the September 1st date when the government have given us the green light to have all students back in school. We want to make the most of the three school days prior to that date, both to reintegrate students and to establish the routines and protocols that will ensure the whole school community is protected upon our return. With this in mind the return to school in August will look like this:

Date	Year Groups in school
Wednesday 26th August	Year 7 students attend school for their first day
Thursday 27th August	Year 7 and Year 11 students are in school
Friday 28th August	Only Years 8,9 & 10 are in school Year 7 & Year 11 students stay at home
Monday 31st August	School closed for Bank Holiday
Tuesday 1st September	All students are in school

By staggering the start date for different year groups we can ensure that we have no more than 50% of students in school at any one time up until 1st September.

We are very much looking forward to having all students back in school from September.
