**Visit to The National Holocaust Centre**  
**Wednesday 28th June 2023**

In Year 9 students study the Holocaust as part of their Religious Education course. To help students gain a better understanding of this tragic period in history a visit has been arranged to the National Holocaust Centre in Laxton, Nottinghamshire. On the day students are guided through some of the main aspects of the Holocaust by an expert at the Centre and then in the afternoon we listen to the real-life story of a Holocaust survivor.

This visit will take place on Wednesday 28th June 2023. The bus will depart The Roundhill Academy at 08:45 and return at approximately 15:30. The cost of the visit will be £7.50 per student, as this is the cost for entrance to The Holocaust Centre. Due to the increased cost of transport, we are travelling via our own school minibuses meaning we can offer the trip without an additional cost for transport. This does mean that we are limited on the number of students that are able to attend. If there are more students wanting to go on the trip than there are places, we will randomly select students by holding a draw. If you would like your child to take part in this trip, please in the first instance register your interest by clicking this link to complete the form <https://forms.office.com/e/KLRFriV00j> by **Friday 28th April**.

If the trip is oversubscribed and we need to hold a draw, you will be notified by email whether or not your child has a place. We will also reconfirm how to make your payment. We will set up a reserve list should places become available.

If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals and the cost of the trip is a barrier to participation, please contact myself in the first instance. As this activity finishes after school hours students will be allowed to take a mobile phone with them. This will need to be switched off for the duration of the trip and may be used on the journey home to contact parents with an estimated time of arrival back at school in case of any unexpected delay. Students will be required to **wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch**.
